General information:

- NRHA entries have to enclose copy of NRHA USA membership card of rider & owner, as well as copy of competition licence and Non Pro card.
- Please enclose copy of horse's registration paper. All horses need to have a horse passport of their home country.
- Nominations will be only accepted with check enclosed for total amount or bank transfer.
- During the whole show the treatment of horses with drugs of foreign substances will not be allowed according to the doping laws. Drug tests could be taken in any class, by show management's choice.
- Price money: Reining classes will have a payback of 25% of the entry/judge fee amount.
Cutting classes will have a payback of 50% of the entry/judge fee amount.
Cutting classes will pay out price money up to the 12th place and will be held according to the AQHA rule book of 2004. Except that one rider could ride as many horses as he would like to show.
- Equipment: During the whole show riders may only use equipment that is allowed during the official show/events.
- Deadline of nomination: May 10, 2004.
- Showground will be opened for incoming travel from Monday, June 7, 2004 on.
- Tickets: Each rider will receive one ticket for every day for the show arena, as well as one ticket for every horse for the remaining facility. Each finalist horse of the Non Pro and Open Reining events will receive another two tickets for the final weekend.
- Hotels: For hotel reservation see hotel list at www.horseacademy.net
- Dogs:
All dogs on the facility need to be kept on a leash. Unrestrained dogs will be detained and can be, for a penalty fee of € 100,00, picked up at the show office. Dogs will not be allowed in the main show arena, party tent or restaurant.
